



Use this soil fact sheet to help you discover the names of the four soil types you have.

### Peat soil

- Very dark colour
- Mostly organic matter
- Holds a lot of moisture



### Clay soil

- Slightly orange colour
- Very fine particles
- Sticky when wet
- Holds a lot of water but water may run off it at first



### Sandy soil

- Light, yellow/brown colour
  - Feels gritty
- Falls through fingers
- Does not hold water well



### Silt soil

- Medium colour
- Feels slippery and smooth
- Small particles
- Holds some water



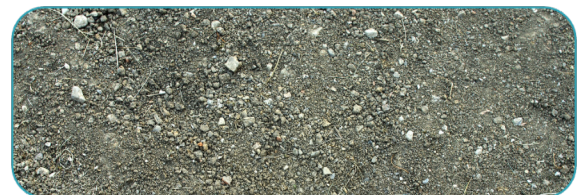
### Loam soil

- Dark/medium colour
- Feels slightly gritty & smooth
  - Holds some water



### Chalky soil

- Light colour
- May have lumps of white stone in it.
- Does not hold water well
