Seconds	Honey bees flutter their wings 190 times a second
Minutes	It takes around 45 minutes for leaf cutter ants to cut up a selection of leaves Venom from a centipede can take affect within a few minutes
Hours	Adult mayflies only live for around 12 hours, whilst they can be in the larva stage for a few years
Days	Some moths only live for a few days
Weeks	Some butterflies only live for a few weeks Worker bees live for a few weeks
Months	Stick insects take 3-4 months to grow from a juvenile to an adult and then live for several months as an adult Pupal phases (metamorphosis) can last for a few months for some insects Some stick insects take 5 months to hatch
Years	Locusts take a few years to be born Cicadas emerge after 17 years and all at the same time Millipedes survived extinction and have lived for millions of years A queen bee can live up to ten years
